ENROLMENT, BLESSING & PRESENTATION OF THE ARCHCONFRATERNITY'S BRONZE MEDAL

The candidates come before the celebrant and stand together, each with a lighted candle. The celebrant then asks the candidates.

Celebrant: What do you ask of God's church?

Servers: The Blessing of Almighty God and enrolment into the

Guild of St. Stephen for Altar Servers.

Celebrant: My dear people, let us pray for those who wish to be

enrolled into the Guild of St. Stephen. Let us ask God to bless them. (pause for silent prayer) Heavenly Father, bless these servers who have been chosen to be members of the Guild of St. Stephen. Grant that they may be faithful in their service at your Altar, and that they may grow in faith and love. We ask this through Christ our Lord.

All: Amen.

The celebrant now questions the candidates, who answer together.

Celebrant: Will you try to say the Guild Prayer every day?

Servers: I will, with the help of God.

Celebrant Will you promise to do your best to serve regularly

particularly when you are needed?

Servers: I will, with the help of God.

Celebrant: Will you promise to serve with care and reverence?

Servers: I will, with the help of God

Celebrant: Will you try to understand what you are doing when you

serve?

Servers: I will, with the help of God.

The servers, who are to be enrolled, now make their solemn promise together. (it is suggested that the celebrant should invite other servers who are present to renew their own promise at the same time).

Servers: I offer myself to God Almighty / to Blessed Mary, our

Mother / and to our Holy Patron, St. Stephen / and I promise to do my best / to serve regularly / with

reverence and understanding / for the glory of God / the service of His Church / and my own eternal salvation.

BLESSING OF MEDALS

Celebrant: Blessed are you, Lord of all creation. You have made us in

your image and likeness and have placed him over all creation to use it for your glory. We ask you to bless (+) these medals, which your servers will wear as a sign of

their service at your Altar.

(the medals are sprinkled with Holy Water)

In the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy

Spirit.

All: Amen.

The celebrant goes to the candidates and receives their lighted candle, as a token of offering themselves. The celebrant places a medal round the neck of each server, saying:

Celebrant: (NAME) receive this medal as a token of your admission

into the Guild of St. Stephen that, with the help of his

prayers, you may lead a good and holy life.

Server: Amen.

The Servers then stand together for the final prayer.

Celebrant: Lord Jesus Christ, you came into this world to serve others,

rather than to be served, and showed yourself to St. Stephen in your glory at the right hand of the Father. We ask you to grant your Altar Servers the faith of St. Stephen,

as they serve you in the Blessed Sacrament, so that they too come to see you in your glory. Who lives and reigns for

ever and ever.

All: Amen.
